TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN

This guide is to help you use the Eastland Port Traffic Management Plan. Here is what you need to know to travel safely through the port.

**A double line is
a two-way road**



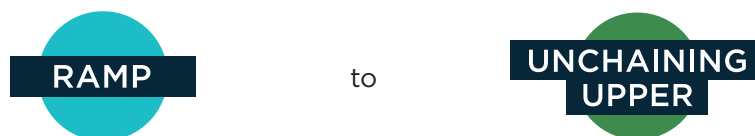
**A solid line is
a one-way road**



How to call your journey on the radio

You will need to announce the name of the road you are on and what landmarks you are travelling from and to. **Note: It is advised you call each landmark as you pass them.**

For example:



“Travelling on **Level Road**, from  to  ”

“Travelling on **Level Road**, from  to  ”

“Travelling on **Upper Road**, from  to  ”

Control of traffic and operational hazards

1. Port-wide speed limit 20km/h, except for Debarker Road which is 15km/h. In addition to this a speed limit of 10km/h is to be used when travelling through or adjacent to construction/temporary works sites.
2. Vehicles must obey all road signs and use marked road routes wherever possible.
3. Vehicle head lights and amber roof lights must be activated when driving in the port.
4. Non-cargo vehicles are not permitted in Wharf areas (see map) while mooring and loading operations take place.
5. Non-cargo vehicles are to park clear of operational areas and personnel are to walk to their destination. Prescribed PPE is to be worn.
6. All pedestrians in areas that are operational must wear hard hats and high visibility clothing. Day/night high viz must be worn at all times.
7. Do not drive or proceed through areas which have been barricaded off with cones, barriers or rope.
8. Obey safety signs and verbal safety instructions from Eastland Port staff at all times.
9. No child under 16 years will be permitted entry to the Port unless the Chief Operating Officer, Regional Infrastructure has given approval in writing.
10. No loading/unloading east of red outline from 9pm to 7am in Upper Log Yard.
